- 2. Share the fundraiser with family, friends, social media, and local news media.
- 3. Add your bank information to start receiving your donations.

Start a GoFundMe

Once you have an active GoFundMe fundraiser that explains your need, you may be considered for a grant from GoFundMe.org. If you're eligible, and funds are available, GoFundMe.org may issue a grant of up to \$1,000 directly to your fundraiser.
